Ceiling lifts

Ceiling lift systems provide a means for safer transfers of individuals who require much assistance for transferring.

Ceiling lifts typically require fewer caregivers, and in some instances allow individuals to transfer themselves independently.

Ceiling lift systems can also provide full bathroom access for bathing and toileting without requiring the need for remodeling.



Motor types and options

FIXED MOTORS

- Mount flush to the track
- Not easily taken off the track
- Provide option of side to side motor

PORTABLE MOTORS

- Can easily be moved from one section of track to another
- Caregiver may utilize a reacher to move the motor to different sections

• TRACK OPTIONS & ROUTING

- Custom configurations are available

Non-permanent and portable options

- Lift gantry system provides a safe patient transfer solution when a permanent solution may not be an option.
- The track stands can be moved from one room to another
- The track stands assemble and take down quickly
- Track can be carried in a carry case for travel portability








Wall or Post Mounted Reach Arm

LRT = Lift-Rotate-Transfer

- Customizable Configuration: can be adapted to fit multiple room configurations including; tight spaces, vaulted ceilings, room-to-room through a doorway, and ceiling heights up to 16
- Reach capability: Boasting a 360- degree rotating articulating arm, it provides an unrivaled 6' arm/ 12' range of motion with a lifting capacity of 300lbs, and 5' arm/ 10' range and a 4' arm/ 8' range, both with a lifting capacity handling of 440lbs.
- Can be used with any portable ceiling lift motor



Uplyft, Self-Transfer System

The Uplyft is a motorized self-transfer device designed to enable individuals with limited mobility to independently and safely transfer between a bed and a wheelchair, or vice versa.

Patient Transfer Lifts

- A patient transfer lifts provide a save and efficient way to transfer patients with limited mobility, reducing injury risk for both the patients and caregivers.
- These lifts come in various types to suit different care environments and patient needs.
- These lifts are often classified as manual or power.



Hoyer transfer lifts

- A hoyer lift transfers patients who cannot bear weight or have minimal mobility; lifts entire body using a sling.
- Suitable for those with little or no upper/lower body strength
- Uses a sling placed under the patient
- May require two (2) caregivers for safety
- Larger footprint, may be harder to maneuver in tight spaces
- Can be manual or powered









Sit-to-Stand lifts

- A sit-to-stand lift assists patients who can bear some weight to move from sitting to standing; supports partial mobility
- Patient must have some leg and upper body strength
- Uses a padded belt and foot platform
- Usually manageable by one caregiver, depending on patient stability
- Generally more compact, easier to use in smaller spaces
- Can be manual or powered



Manual sit-to-stand lifts

- For individuals with the ability to come to standing and decent trunk balance
- Assists those with limited endurance and diminished ability to weight shift.
- Caregiver can easily move individual to different area of the house (including into the bathroom when space permits).
- No power or battery requirements.



Power sit-to-stand lifts

- Requires start from sitting position
- Provides opportunity for weight bearing
- Allows easier access to pants for toileting/commode transfers
- May remove foot platform for walking with on the ground with support from the lift.
- Available weight capacity up to 600 lbs.







Slings used with hoyer and sit-to-stand lifts

Patient lift slings are designed for specific patient needs and transfer scenarios

- Varied materials and styles to suit the individual.
- Sling options for exercise, repositioning, limb elevation, and assist with cares.
- Full-Body (full back) Slings provide maximum support, including the head, neck, and shoulders
- *Universal (divided leg) Slings* feature a "U" shaped design that supports the back and wraps under the thighs, allowing for easier placement and removal while the patient is seated.
- Commode/Toileting Slings designed with an opening to facilitate toileting and hygiene tasks.
- **Sit-to-Stand (Stand-Aid) Slings** used with sit-to stand lifts for patients who can bear some weight, these slings support the lower back and thighs, helping patient transition from sitting to standing.
- Repositioning and Limb Slings specialized slings for repositioning patients in bed or supporting specific limbs during care tasks.









Independent Lifter Harness

The Independent Lifter Harness (aka Independent Lifter) is a specialized patient transfer device designed to enable users with moderate upper body strength and good cognitive function to perform self-transfers using a ceiling lift system without the need for a traditional sling.
